Join our clinical research study and help us find serious treatments.

You may be able to be in a clinical research study if you suffer from the pain experienced after having shingles, also known as post-herpetic neuralgia (PHN). The purpose of this study is to see if an investigational pain drug works safely to reduce PHN pain.

You may be able to be in this study if you:

- Are at least 18 years old
- Have had a diagnosis of PHN and associated pain for at least 3 months
- Are able to stop taking other treatments for PHN while in the study

The staff at The Neurological Institute will go over other requirements with you. If you choose to take part in the study, you can expect 10 study visits. Your time in the study will last about 5 months. There is no cost to you for all study-related office visits, medical exams, and study medicine.
